Application Submission Instructions for Department Staff

These instructions are to aid academic departments in submitting applications for Foreign Language and Area Studies fellowships to the National Resource Centers (NRCs) at Illinois. Questions regarding application procedures and materials can be forwarded to any of the Centers noted below, or emailed to FLAS-Fellowships@illinois.edu.

Departments are encouraged to set an internal FLAS application deadline to ensure that there is ample time to compile and rank the applications before the submission deadline.

FLAS Eligibility

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Currently enrolled as a graduate student OR accepted by the department for graduate admission. (Departments wishing to use the FLAS fellowship to recruit an incoming student should indicate this clearly on the application cover sheet.)

FLAS Application Submission Instructions

1. Verify that the student is eligible for a FLAS (see above).
2. Students must apply using the online application. For incoming students contact FLAS-fellowships@illinois.edu for the link to the online application for these students, please include the names of the students in the email.
3. Applications must be submitted by the department to the appropriate Center.
4. Departments submitting more than one applicant **MUST** rank them.
5. Applications are due to the Center(s) by 5:00 pm on Friday, 13 February 2009.
6. **Submit a complete set of supporting documents to each Center** to which the students is applying (please refer to the cover sheet check list for the list of documents).
7. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
8. **DO NOT STAPLE Documents**; secure each application with a binder or paper clip.
