### Application Submission Instructions for Students

These instructions must be followed in submitting Foreign Language and Area Studies fellowship applications. #### FLAS Eligibility

1. U.S. citizenship or permanent residency
2. Currently enrolled as a graduate student or applying for graduate admission.

#### What, When, and Where of Application Submission

1. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Refer to the Cover Sheet for a checklist.
2. **FLAS Applications must be submitted by YOUR home department.**
3. Applications are due **FROM** the home department no later than 5:00 pm, 13 February 2009.
4. Check with your department for their internal application deadline.
5. Read the eligibility requirements above before applying.
6. Check each Center's web site for specific application criteria.
7. Complete the on-line application form: [www.FLAS.illinois.edu/application.html](http://www.FLAS.illinois.edu/application.html)
8. Prepare a **complete set of supporting documents for each Center** to which you are applying.
9. **DO NOT STAPLE your documents**; each application must be bound with a paper clip.

#### FLAS Application Instructions

You cannot save the application and return to it later. Be prepared to answer the following:

1. Full name, UIN, and preferred mailing address
2. Prior FLAS awards (quantity and Center)
3. GRE scores and percentages, current degree program, program code, and year in program
4. Previous schools attended (up to 3): degree, date, and discipline
5. List of references
6. Language request and level; summer requests also require the program name, location, contact information, estimate of tuition (do not include room and board).
